

# FIFTIETH ARADHANA CELEBRATIONS OF SADGURU SRI GNANANANDAGIRI SWAMIGAL

The advent of our Sadguru Swami Gnanananda Giri is a mystery and must have been some time in the early 19th century. He was born in Mangalapuri of Kamataka State. He left his house at very early age. He offered himself to his Guru Sri Swami Sivaratna Giri of Jyotir Mutt who by his grace enveloped and took possession of him. After Mahasamadhi of his Guru, He adorned the Peetam for some time and retired to remote heights of Himalayas for intense penance. He has spent many years at icy caves of Himalayas in contemplation and meditation. After a long period of seclusion Sri Sadgurudev travelled extensively on foot spanning whole of India, Tibet, Nepal, Burma and Sri Lanka.

During the middle of last century Sri Sadgurudev chose a small village on the northern banks of River Dakshina Pinagini, near Tirukovilur, and instituted a spiritual retreat, Sri Gnanananda Thapovanam, which is sanctified by ancient Sages, Mrigandu, Kapila, Gnana Desika, the well-known Tamil Saint Avvaiyar, the three Alwars of Vaishnava traditions, and Sri Ragothama Swamigal's Moola Brindavan. Sri Sadgurudev also established Ashrams at Attayampatti, Siddhalingamadam and Yercaud.

Sadguru Sri Gnanananda is a baffling enigma to the modern intellectuals but an open book with the disarming simplicity of a child of God to the common man, Swamiji swore by tradition but went beyond it in his glorious ministry spanning well over a century nobody knows for certain how long. He breathed the essence of God-knowledge, the Paravidya, but amazed everyone with his grasp of the intricacies of the complex texture of the prevailing material civilization. He would draw himself on to the summits of Brahmic Nirvana and the next moment join hilarious children on their swing. There was hardly a line of Yoga with which he was not acquainted or a major experience in spiritual life that he had not undergone.

Sri Gnanananda's whole personality radiated wonderfully pure and tender love. A love which was totally given to each and yet was the same for all. So the joy of feeling oneself loved by him carried with it a high degree of detachment; for we all dream of being loved with a distinct and preferential love. But this love enveloped each one at the same time as if uniquely. You felt that for him all distinction, Bheda, was annulled and had vanished. In each disciple it was as if he directly perceived the truest personality the self alone, the Atman.

The Swami would look at the devotee with eyes full of tenderness and love. When the devotee made his parting obeisance, the Swami would take special care to give him a 'Prasada'. At the end, the Swami would tell the devotee softly in an endearing tone, with an affectionate gentle smile, "Meendum Sandippom" - We will meet again.

The Swami was always totally absorbed at the time of the worship of Guru Padukas. The Pada Pooja or the worship of the Padukas of Acharya Sankara and Sri Gnanananda Giri Swami takes place every day at the Ashram at Sri Gnanananda Thapovanam.

Swami Gnanananda also significantly declares: "A true disciple has no Sadhana to perform. He has only to surrender himself completely to his Guru". Nothing could be simpler for the aspirant if there is the proper attitude. Nothing could be nobler than the Guru's willingness to take over the disciple.

The great spiritual Genius, our Guiding Light, passed into eternity in January 1974, responding to His Master's Divine call.

With the Grace and blessings of Sadguru Sri Gnanananda Giri Swamigal, it is decided to celebrate the Fiftieth Aradhana Festival at Sri Gnanananda Thapovanam. There will be Bhajans, Upanyasam, Nama Sankeerthanam, Music Concert from Thursday the 14th December 2023 to 29 December 2023.

The traditional ARADHANA, the special Pada Pooja and Maha Abhisheka and Pooja at the Shrine of Grace of His Adhishtana will take place on Thursday the 28th December 2023. (Margazhi Krishna Paksha Dwititya).

All devotees are cordially invited to participate in the celebrations and receive Sri Sadguru's Grace and Blessings. The detailed programme of the celebrations is given overleaf.
